

We have lost a great leader, Sonia grieves demise of Pranab

New Delhi, Sept 1: Congress leaders, including former prime minister Manmohan Singh and party chief Sonia Gandhi, condoled the death of former president Pranab Mukherjee, remembering him as India's finest statesman and a visionary leader.

Singh said the nation has lost one of its greatest leaders.

"I have learnt with profound sorrow about the passing away of Shri Pranab Mukherjee, former president of India. In his death, our country has lost one of its greatest leaders of Independent India. He and I worked very closely in the government of India and I depended on him a great deal for his wisdom, vast knowledge and experience of public affairs," Singh said in his condolence message.

Mukherjee died on Monday in

the Army's Research and Referral Hospital here, his son Abhijit said. He was 84. In a letter to Mukherjee's daughter Sharmistha, Sonia Gandhi said his life over the past five decades mirrored 50 years of India's history. Congress leader Rahul Gandhi said, "With great sadness, the nation receives the news of the unfortunate demise of our former President Shri Pranab Mukherjee." The government announced a seven-day mourning as a mark of respect.

Other Congress leaders, including Ahmed Patel, Priyanka Gandhi Vadra, Mallikarjun Kharge and Adhir Ranjan Chowdhury, also expressed grief over Mukherjee's demise.

Patel said Mukherjee was like his elder brother. "His demise has left a permanent vacuum in India's public life. He was an en-

cyclopaedia of Indian politics," he said.

Priyanka Gandhi said the entire nation has suffered an irreparable loss.

"Pranab da was a guiding force for the entire Congress family and was an able politician. My deep condolences. May God grant courage to his family in this hour of grief to bear this loss," she tweeted.

Biden recalls Pranab's role in enlarging Indo-US ties

Washington, Sept 1: Pranab Mukherjee believed deeply in the importance of India and the US tackling global challenges together, Democratic presidential candidate Joe Biden has said, condoling the death of the former president.

Several other prominent US leaders and organisations also condoled Mukherjee's death, saying he will go down in history among India's most distinguished statesmen and scholars.

The 84-year-old

veteran politician died after he suffered a septic shock on Sunday. He died of a cardiac arrest on Monday evening following a 21-day battle with multiple ailments.

"President Shri Pranab Mukherjee was a devout public servant who believed deeply in the importance of our two nations tackling global challenges together. Jill and I are saddened to hear of his passing - our prayers go out to his loved ones and the Indian people," Biden

said on Monday.

As a Senator, in particular as member of the Senate Foreign Relations Committee and its chairman and later as the vice president of the United States, Biden had a strong friendship with Mukherjee, who was one of the most well-known Indian leaders in the US.

According to Deputy Secretary of State Stephen Biegun, a strong US-India partnership will be one of Mukherjee's many lasting legacies.

"He'll go down in

history among India's most distinguished statesmen and scholars, and his many visits to Washington, everything he did for the relationship, played an instrumental role in expanding this US-India relationship, both in defence and external affairs when he was the minister," the top American diplomat said during the virtual India US Leadership Summit organised by the US India Strategic and Partnership Forum (USISPF).

US VP Pence reiterates strong India-US ties

Washington, Sept. 1: Vice President Mike Pence on Monday reaffirmed America's commitment to a free and open Indo-Pacific

and said a strong US-India partnership is in their strategic interests, amid China flexing its muscles in the region.

Speaking at a virtual event on the US-India organized by the US-India Strategic Partnership Forum (USISPF), a non-profit organization, Pence said that American strength first comes from its militarily and economically, but also from the strength of relationships.

"There's no question that that the relationship that has been forged over the years, and then under President Trump and Prime Minister Narendra Modi has never been stronger," he said, adding that it will strengthen the hands of those of who want to see a future of freedom in the Indo-Pacific, and a future of freedom cross Asia.

The Chinese military has been flexing its

muscles in the Indo-Pacific region and is also engaged in hotly contested territorial disputes in both the South China Sea (SCS) and the East China Sea (ECS).

China claims nearly all of the South China Sea, though Taiwan, the Philippines, Brunei, Malaysia and Vietnam all claim parts of it.

Beijing has built up

and militarized many of the islands and reefs it controls in the region.

Both the SCS and the ECS are stated to be rich in minerals, oil and other natural resources and are also vital to global trade.

Responding to a question on China, Pence said that most of the tariffs President Trump imposed on China are all still in place.

'Clear indications of community spread in rural areas'

Experts moot reopening schools in graded manner

New Delhi Sept. 1: A group of public health experts has recommended that schools and other educational institutions should be reopened in

a graded manner while highlighting that the lockdown should be discontinued as a strategy for control of the spread of coronavirus.

The nationwide lockdown induced by COVID-19 in March prompted schools and colleges to move to the virtual world for teaching and learning activities.

The recommendations were made in a report compiled by experts from the Indian Public Health Association (IPHA), Indian Association of Preventive and Social Medicine (IAPSM) and the Indian Association of Epidemiologists (IAE).

Recommending that the opening of schools and other educational institutions could be started in a graded manner, the experts said it is time now to move towards normalcy.

"There should be a pragmatic approach, especially in areas where sufficient population is already infected with SARS CoV-2 (As assessed by expert committee). Even in low infection areas, schools may be opened with due safety measures (social distancing, alternate work days, etc.), and with adequate surveillance for any outbreaks acceleration due to schools," they said.

The experts said closure of educational institutions, especially schools for children (5-18 years) has had a significant impact on the teaching-learning

system as well as mental health of the children.

"The impact has been disproportionately higher on the children of lower socio-economic strata who do not have social capital for alternatives like digital platforms.

Sufficient evidence is available that infected, young children are at an extremely low risk of developing morbidity," they said.

The risk of young children transmitting corona infection to older family members would be the same as adult family members who are permitted to carry out activities outside of home environment, they said.

They also said the lockdown as a strategy for control of the contagion should be discontinued.

"Geographically limited restrictions for short periods may be imposed in epidemiologically defined clusters. Cluster restrictions should be considered only in areas with no community transmission," they said.

The primary purpose of the lockdown was to slow down the pandemic and gain time for preparedness to fight it, and this purpose has already been achieved, the report said.
